Our annual dead-lift for dollars is a fun way for the Peak Family and their family's to give back to the community and make an impact. We are very excited for the 8th ANNUAL Event! It is important to set realistic dead-lift goals based on your current training, please be sure to discuss your goal with your coach as you make your decision.

Over the past 7 years you have raised over \$75,000 for Paint GA Pink and 100% of those funds go directly to those impacted in our local community!

Paint GA Pink is unique in that 100% of their funds go to patients who are undergoing treatments so that they can maintain a quality of life throughout this trialing time (IE to help pay for their mortgage, food, etc). The money does not go to research or staff.

Rules

1. Participants may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in at the Dead-Lift for Dollars event, Saturday, August 11th 2018**
2. Pledges may be made by anyone. However, participants may not ask for pledges from any of the staff members of Paint Georgia Pink. **Please ask everyone who pledges if their company has a matching gift fund policy.**
3. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per pound, and maximum pledge.** Participants may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected and turn them all in at the same time.
4. On Dead-Lift for Dollars day, there will be three Flights of Deadlifting, each based on your starting attempt. Flight times will be announced once signups are done.
5. Upon completion of the Dead-Lift For Dollars, participants will record their weights lifted. Participants may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with the all money to Caleb or Kelly Williams at Peak Strength and Fitness as she will be giving all the donations to Paint Georgia Pink by Monday, August 20th!**
